



Corporate Snake courses

- Equipment to be used when capturing a Black Mamba
- Practical handling of wild Black Mambas. (This is to ensure that everyone has hands on experience of what to expect when encountering a Black Mamba in the wild.)

Applicable to companies that are situated in areas where black mambas occur, particularly in areas like Limpopo, North West, Mpumalanga and KZN provinces as well as area north of South Africa and other parts of Africa)

Snake Identification, Snakebite treatment, First Aid protocol with Venomous Snake Handling R2100 per person (VAT incl.) with a minimum of 10 people per session, traveling and accommodation will be added where applicable
